I. How can I keep from committing the same sin over and over again?

Colossians 3:5-6; 1 John 3:2 NIV

We can experience victory over habitual and repetitious sin. *Matthew 5:29-30 NIV*

Jesus uses hyperbole to show us that we need to get radical about dealing with our sin.

We need a short-term plan to address our behavior.

We need a long-term plan to change our hearts.

Four things we can do to change our hearts:

1. Commit ourselves to scripture.
2. Commit ourselves to prayer.
3. Confess our sin.
4. Fast.

II. Will God really send people to hell who haven't heard about Jesus?

Matthew 7:7-8; Acts 10:1-5, 47-48 NIV
