I. Single People Issues:

1. What do you do about high maintenance friendships that suck the life out of you?

Three kinds of people in our lives:

- VDPs: Very Drainning People
- VNPs: Very Nice People
- VIPs: Very Inspiring People

2. What if I fall in love with someone who doesn't share my faith? *2 Corinthians 6:14*

Four reasons to only date a fellow believer:

- You can share the same treasure.
 - You can build from the same blueprint.
 - You can access the same strength.
 - You can live by the same values.
3. How do I know it's the right person? *Genesis 2:24*
 4. How do I set boundaries in dating?

The lines you need to draw on physical contact: "Nothing below the neck, don't lay down, don't take anything off."

II. Marriage People Issues:

1. My spouse doesn't want to have sex with me...is that normal? *1 Corinthians 7:4-5*
2. What do I do about my obnoxious mother-in-law? *Matthew 19:4-5*
3. If I'm married to an unbeliever and I'm miserable...do I need to stay with them? *1 Peter 3:1-2*
4. What does Jesus say about divorce and remarriage? *Matthew 19:8-9*
5. What are the Biblical grounds for divorce?
 - Divorce is allowed for sexual immorality. *Matthew 19:9*
 - Divorce is allowed for desertion. *1 Corinthians 7:15; 1 Timothy 5:8*
6. So, when does Jesus approve of a divorced person remarrying?

Circumstances in which a previously married believer has the approval from Jesus to remarry:

- Your former spouse is deceased. *Romans 7:2* - You are free to marry...but they must be a follower of Jesus.
- Your divorce occurred prior to your conversion to Christ. *II Corinthians 5:17*
- Your divorce was caused by sexual immorality of your spouse. *Matthew 19:3-9*
- You were deserted by an unbelieving spouse. *1 Corinthians 7:15*
- Your spouse initiated the divorce and has remarried. *Deuteronomy 24:1-4; Romans 7:3*
- Your divorce was caused by your sexual immorality, you are repentant and your spouse has remarried.

1 John 1:9

7. Why is it so hard to forgive and then trust again after sexual immorality?
 - Forgiveness is the hardest, most expensive gift you can give or receive.
 - Forgiveness is a process.
 - Forgiveness and trust take time.
